4. REPORTS

a) Bull Moose (CTU's monthly meeting regarding potential legislation) – Jim McGannon willing to step up to take Reed's place. He sat in on Winter Quarterly call.

b) CTU Winter Meeting - Pam listened in on the CTU Winter quarterly call and felt it was very informative.

c) Karen distributed a list of Arkansas River related conservation groups (need contact folks, liaison names, contact info-attached). Please send her updates for the blanks.

d) Volunteer Flow Management Plan – Bob – top of Fry Ark (trans mt) snowpack looks good. 125cfs being released now for import water to run until 5/1. Could change. 360cfs at Wellsville. Pueblo will release during 7/1-15 which helps rafters. They've been very helpful. Colorado Springs usually does their water exchanges during high water. Low soil moisture content really hurts the runoff. 100% snowpack could be 57% runoff with low soil moisture. Every 10 years they recalculate what "100%" is. Now is not what the 80's were.

e) Arkansas River Basin Forum 4/28-29 in Salida. We should get registration from Bob. Doing a raft trip Thursday afternoon. \$100/day or \$200/day - UABWF.org. Pam will see if we've done sponsorship in the past.

f) Lowhead dam removal in Salida – Bob - concern about how much silt could be behind there. Engineering not done. Bill has engineering plans.

g) Roger Hill case in Texas Creek update. Roger said he accessed the water legally and walked up riverbed below high water line and was challenged by the landowners with rocks and a gun. It is still in court.
